All applications must be emailed to ICPRHAC@GMAIL.COM. Include in the subject headline "JCPRHAC SCHOLARSHIP" and submit the application by July 30, 2020. Awardees will be notified via email on August 16, 2020 the day we would have celebrated our Annual Puerto Rican Day Parade. Scholarship recipients will be recognized on all the JCPRHAC media platforms. Scholarship Information will be forwarded to the accredited university the applicant is attending. "Incomplete Applications Will Not Be Eligible For Consideration"

Scholarship Criteria:

- Latino High School Graduates
- Enrolled as a full-time student for Fall 2020 semester (at least 12 semester credits of coursework)
- Overall GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Community Service/Extracurricular activities while in high school

A complete application with all of the following items must be submitted by the deadline:

- 1. JCPRHAC Scholarship Application
- 2. Personal Statement Two Page, double spaced, Times New Roman, 12 point font
 - a. Essay should include personal background, achievements, and financial need.
- 3. Two letters of recommendation:
 - a. Character Reference: Letter from non-relative who is familiar with students character
 - b. Academic Reference: Letter from a teacher or professor familiar with academic success.
- 4. High School Academic Transcript
